Course Objectives:

1. To provide musical enrichment for the students of DSC.
2. To help students develop advanced concepts of good singing.

Accompanist: The student will obtain the services of an accompanist to be available for at least one half of the lesson time.

Music: The student will play an active role selecting music to be studied for the semester. It is also expected that the student will obtain his or her own copies of music being studied.
