Course Objectives:

1. To provide musical enrichment for the students of DSC.
2. To help students develop advanced concepts of good singing.
3. To introduce the student to an appropriate solo repertoire.

Outcome Assessment: The final grade will be based on preparation and progress in lessons and on attendance (see below).

Attendance Policy: There will be 12 half hour lessons during the semester. Any student unable to attend a scheduled lesson is required to notify the instructor at least a day in advance excepting emergencies. Otherwise, the student forfeits the right to make up that lesson. Please do not attend if you are contagious with illness. Any student missing 4 or more lessons without explanation will automatically earn an "F" for the semester.

Lessons missed by the instructor will be made up at the mutual convenience of both student and teacher.

Accompanist: The student will need to obtain the services of an accompanist to be available for at least one half of the lesson times. You are responsible for providing music for your accompanist well ahead of time so that they can practice.

Music: The student will play an active role in selecting music to be studied for the semester. It is also expected that the student will obtain his or her own copies of music being studied.

Student Voice Recital: Performing in a recital is highly recommended to provide performance experience. Also attending a recital is for the benefit of all, because you can learn a lot from other performers.
