COURSE DESCRIPTION:

Private piano lessons are designed to help the student develop fluency in music reading, piano technique, practice skills, and their performance at the piano. Lessons will be geared to the level of each student. A weekly lesson time will be arranged.

COURSE REQUIREMENTS

1. Attendance at weekly lesson.
2. Regular daily practice: 1-2 hours per day for the non-music major. Music majors are expected to practice 4 hours per day.
3. Attendance at performance classes.

GRADING:

Grades will be determined by attendance at lessons, the amount of individual practice time, the quality of preparation for each lesson, and overall progress during the semester.

REQUIRED BOOKS:

The texts and books required will be matched to the level of the student's development, and will be assigned by the teacher. Books are available at local music stores.
