File Description:

The Student Data Submission file contains demographic records for all the students for a particular extract. The Student Data Submission File is submitted five times per fiscal year (Summer EOT, Fall 3rd-Week, Fall EOT, Spring 3rd-Week, and Spring EOT).

Capture Date:

The capture date for each 3rd-Week extract is the 3rd-Week date of the Semester.

Submission File Usage:

The Student Data Submission File will be used for reporting of Student Headcount, Performance Evaluations, Data Book, Workforce Services Economic Indicators, TRIO program tracking, student tracking, and others as necessary.

Submission File Naming Convention:

The Student Data Submission File should be named as follows:

School short name (hyphen), file description (**s** for students, **c** for courses, and **sc** for student_courses) (hyphen) , year/term extension (**093** for 2009 and third term), extract period (**3** for 3rd-Week or **E** for EOT). File extension csv or txt may be used.

example: **wsu-s-0933.txt** or **wsu-s-0933.csv**

for Weber State University's 3rd-Week Student File for Spring (2008/2009).

Delimiter:

The Student Data Submission File may be submitted in either fixed field or delimited format. A single pipe symbol '|' will be used as the delimiter. When submitting a delimited file, the pipe symbol must appear between each field in the file (Note: some data elements will have multiple fields, e.g. ethnicity has 8 fields). Column spacing references are provided for those wishing to submit data in a fixed length format.
