### **Course Work:**

The student's final grade will be determined by her/his performance on homework, exams, class activities & projects.

- Homework: I will assign homework during each class. Homework will be collected after each chapter. Points will be deducted by two points per day for late homework. The homework may be graded on a scale from 0-20. Show all work. Neatness is everything. Do not hand in incomplete homework. Most of the time, a list of answers is not sufficient, you must show work.
- Exams: There will be 5 exams and a comprehensive final. Each student is expected to take the examinations as scheduled in the syllabus. Make-up exams will be given at the discretion of instructor, and only if prior arrangements have been made.
- Grading: Exams – 60% total (12% each), Final – 20%, Homework – 20%. Grades will be assigned as follows: **A** (94-100%), **A-** (90-93%), **B+** (87-89%), **B** (83-86%), **B-**(80-82%), **C+**(75-79%), **C** (70-74%), **C-**(65-69%), **D+**(60-64%), **D**(55-59%), **D-**(50-54%), **F**(0-49%)
