

General Requirements for an ASSOCIATE OF ARTS DEGREE

Compared to the Associate of Science degree, the Associate of Arts degree has:

- A foreign language requirement (AS does not have this requirement)
- No oral communication course (AS requires one course)
- Two science courses (AS requires three)

COMMUNICATION SKILLS (CS), 2 courses/6 credits.
Take ENGL 1010 and ENGL 2010 (2011 if business major)
Note: You must pass ENGL 1010 with a C- or better before entering ENGL 2010 or 2011.

FOREIGN LANGUAGE SKILLS (FL), 2 courses/8 credits.
Receive credit by exam, vertical credit, or take two classes.

MATHEMATICS (MA), 1 course/3 credits (must pass with C or better).
MATH 1030, 1050, 1060, 1090, 1100, 1210, 1220, 2210 (1050 recommended for transferring, 1090 for a business major)

COMPUTER SKILLS (CP) 1 course/3 credits.
Take or test out of CIS 1200.

NATURAL SCIENCES (LS and PS), 2 courses/6 credits.
Take two courses. One course must be from the life sciences (LS), one course must be from the physical sciences (PS).

LIFE SCIENCES (LS) 1 course (3 credits)
BIOL 1010, 1030

PHYSICAL SCIENCES (PS) 1 course (3 credits)
CHEM 1010, 1110, 1210, 2310, GEOG 1200, GEOL 1010, 1020, 1040, 1110, 2310,
PHSX 1010, 1020, 1030, 2010, 2210

AMERICAN INSTITUTIONS (AI), 1 course/3 credits.
HIST 1700 or POLS 1100

SOCIAL SCIENCES (SS), 1 course/3 credits.
ECON 1010, 2010, 2020, PSYC 1010, 1100, FCS 1500, 2400, GEOG 1400, HIST 1010,
1020, SOC 1010, 1020, 1200, ANTH 1010

FINE ARTS (FA)/HUMANITIES (HU), 3 courses/9 credits
Take three courses. At least one course must be from the fine arts group, and at least one course must be a literature (lit) course. If you take two courses from the fine arts group, those courses must be from two different programs.

FINE ARTS (FA) 1 or 2 course(s) (3 or 6 credits)
TA 1010, 1050, ART 1010, 1020, 1030, 1100, MUS 1010, 2010, 2020, DANC 1010

HUMANITIES (HU) 1 or 2 course(s) (3 or 6 credits)
ENGL 2110(lit), 2120(lit), 2130(lit), 2250(lit), 2260(lit), 2300(lit), 2310(lit), 2320(lit), 2330(lit),
2340(lit), 2400(lit), 2410(lit), 2500(lit), 2520(lit), 2530(lit), or 2600(lit), TA 1020(lit),
SPAN 2310 and 2320(lit) (must take both SPAN classes to meet Lit req.)
HUM 1010, 1020, 1030, 2130, 2140, PHIL 1010, 1500
