

Bachelor in Accounting Degree – Additional Program Information & Advanced Standing Requirements

Students who pursue the Bachelor in Accounting degree at Dixie State College of Utah take a variety of Accounting courses as well as learn the ability to track or record business transactions and provide the information that managers need to make informed business decisions. Students also get involved in learning tax implications for individual and business entities. Students in this major take a series of Accounting requirements including Financial and Managerial Accounting, Cost Accounting, Tax Accounting I & II and Auditing, among others. The degree is also an excellent choice for students wishing to pursue Master of Accountancy (MAcc) degree.

Udvar-Hazy School of Business Application for Advanced Standing

Advanced standing status must be obtained prior to enrollment in any 3000 or above business courses. Students will need to meet with a business advisor and submit an Application for Advanced Standing prior to taking 3000 or above level business courses.

***Note:** The Udvar-Hazy School of Business allows one semester of conditional advanced standing during which students can start taking 3000 or above courses while completing pre-business requirements in the same semester.

To apply for advanced standing you must:

1) Complete the following pre-business courses with a minimum C- and an overall Business GPA of at least 2.5:

ACCT 2010	Financial Accounting
ACCT 2020	Managerial Accounting
CIS 2010	Business Computer Proficiency (B- or better)
COMM 1020 or 2110	Communications
ECON 2010	Micro Economics
ECON 2020	Macro Economics
ENGL 2010	Intermediate Writing
MATH 1100	Business Calculus
STAT 2040	Business Statistics
MGMT 2050	Business Law

2) Submit an application for advanced standing with the business advisor during **the semester prior to** completing pre-business courses. Applications for advanced standing are submitted during a personal appointment with:

*Conditional acceptance may be granted if all remaining pre-business courses can be taken during the semester of conditional acceptance. If you do not complete the remaining lower division credits successfully (while earning a minimum C- grade in each course, unless otherwise indicated, and maintaining a 2.5 pre-business GPA and a 2.0 overall GPA), conditional advanced standing will be revoked. Students with revoked conditional advanced standing will not be allowed to take any further upper division courses until all pre-business courses are completed and the minimum GPA standards have been met.

- Students must follow the pre- and/or co-requisites designated for each pre-business requirement, which are listed on the business degree program requirements. You can access the requirements at:

(All pre-business courses and all upper division business courses must be completed with a minimum C- grade. CIS 2010 requires B- or better.)

- If you are a **transfer student**, you must also make sure that **ALL** of your transcripts (official copies) have been sent to the Registrar's office at Dixie State College.

- The application criteria listed above DO NOT GUARANTEE ACCEPTANCE, but are indicative of the minimum qualifications of students seeking acceptance to, or advanced standing in, the Udvar-Hazy School of Business.
