|  | "If that individual (Chair) represents an academic college, s/he retains voting rights as a representative of that college." <br> There is an "Extraordinary Circumstance" clause in Policy 101.4.6 that allows the President to implement a policy change with the requirement that the policy be revised during the academic year using standard approval processes. <br> Department Chairs will be added to membership of the Academic Council. The Academic Council has the final approval in the internal curriculum approval process. This will ensure that chairs retain their voting rights on curriculum matters. |
